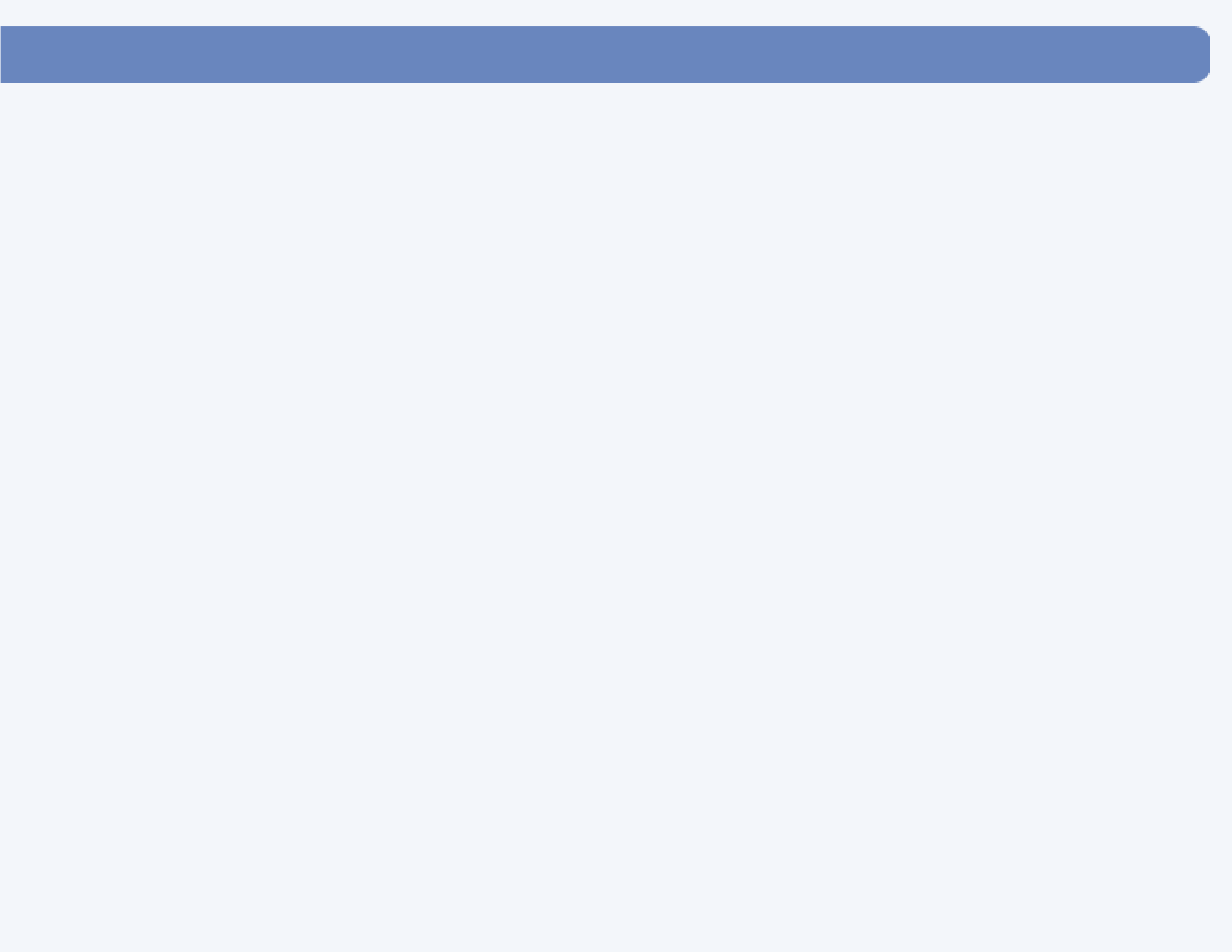


Child care staff are certified according to the requirements of the licence by facility type. An early childhood centre requires a Type I licence; a family child care home or school-age child care centre requires a Type II licence.

In Type 1 centres



A centre director requires a one-year ECE certificate or equivalent.

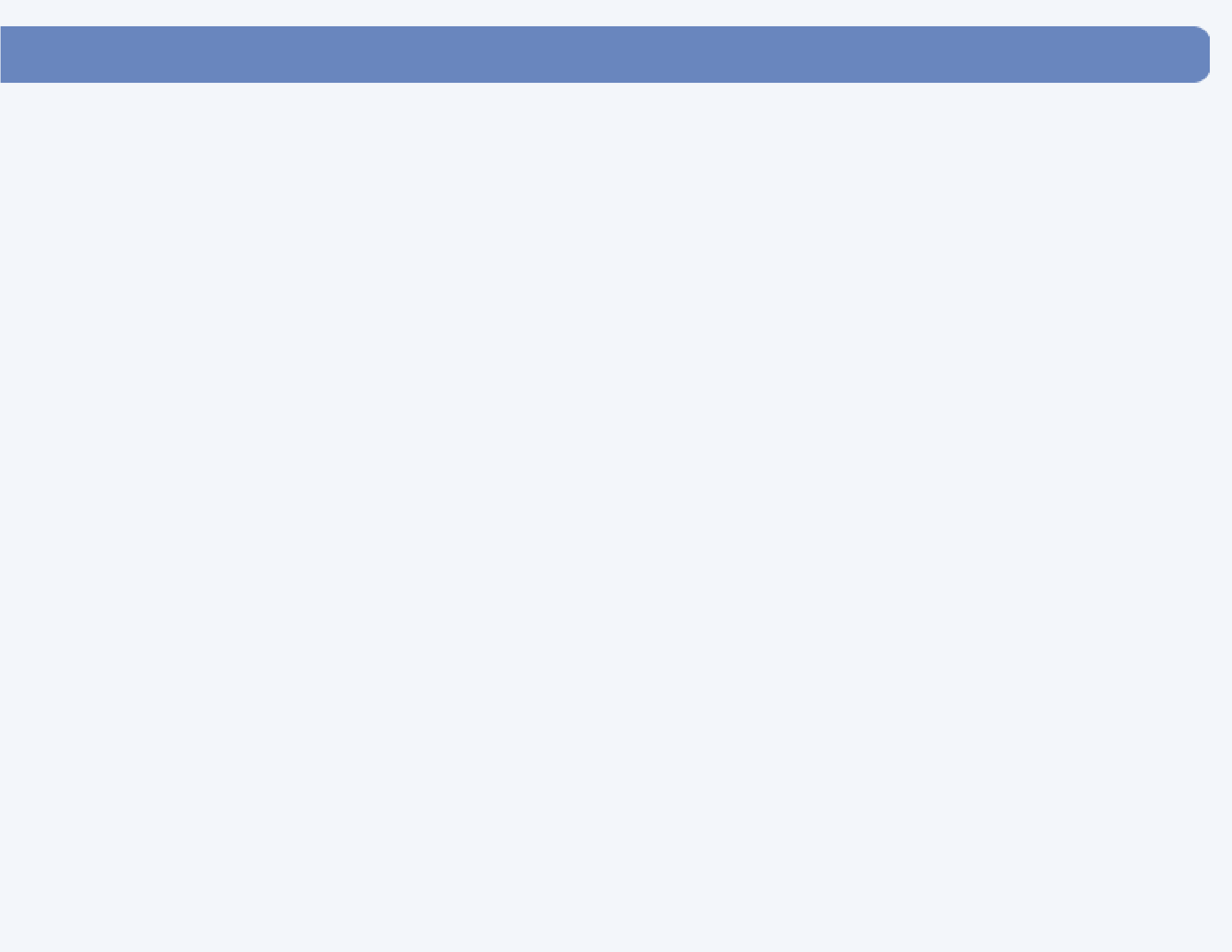

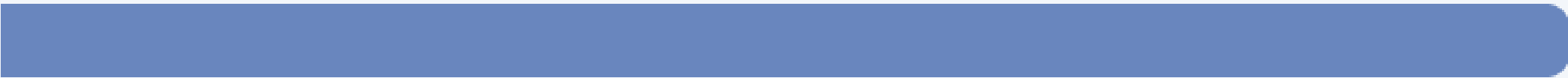
NB does not have a certification, classification, or registry system for early childhood educators. A minimum of one in two (50%) staff included in the child-to-staff ratio must hold a one-year certificate in early childhood education from a recognized post-secondary institution.

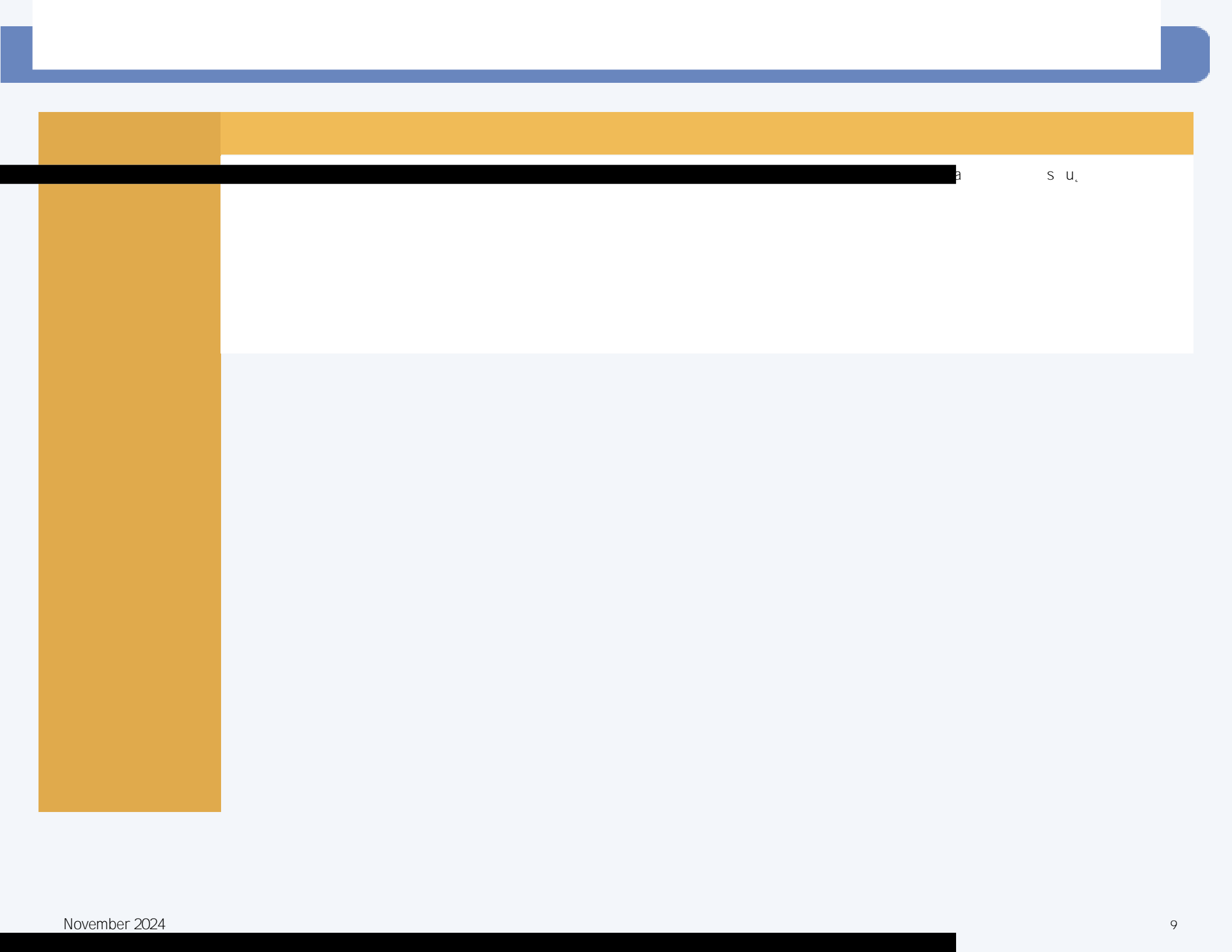

Centre operators must be at least 19 years of age and show proof of vaccination and criminal record check, which must be updated every 5 years.

No minimum training requirements in legislation.

Must be at least 19 years of age, have a clear tuberculosis test, proof of vaccination, and a criminal record check that is updated every 5 years. All staff must also hold a first aid certificate, and where available, CPR training.

Support staff may be under the age of 19 and work under the supervision of a primary staff person.

An operator of a centre must be at least 19 years of age and have completed a post-secondary program in child development satisfactory to the Director of Child Day Care Services or satisfactorily demonstrate an understanding of developmentally appropriate practices and the ability to apply that understanding in the child care program.
